## PROJECT OVERVIEW

Our Dartmouth-Boston University-Muhimbili (DBM) Fogarty HIV training program is building upon our prior Fogarty-supported capacity building activities and train research faculty to conduct HIV and HIV/TB epidemiologic research and clinical trials at the planned for established Infectious Disease Institute (IDI) at Muhimbili University of Health and Allied Sciences (MUHAS).
